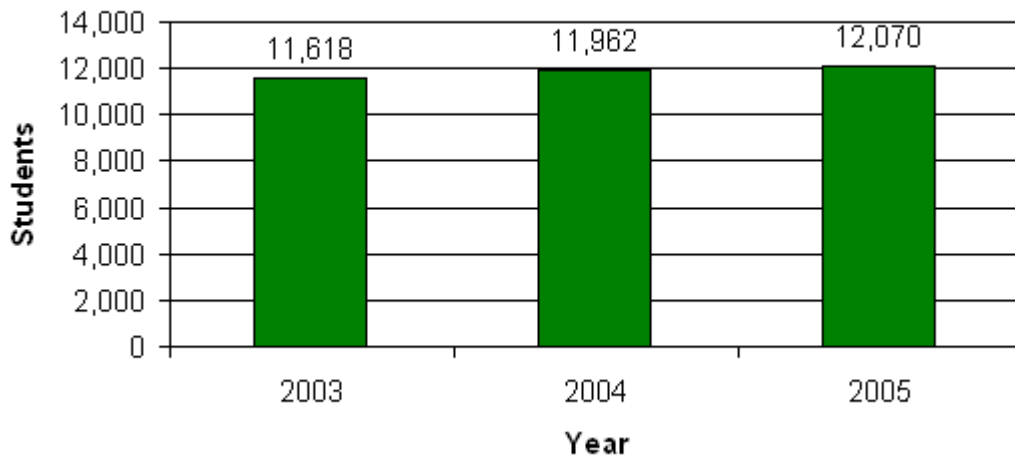
These data reflect current FAEIS data and should be viewed as a sample of the population of information for this discipline. To improve the data, please consider adding or updating your data.

We intend to create additional newsletters to feature other disciplines. We hope that you find these newsletters to be useful!

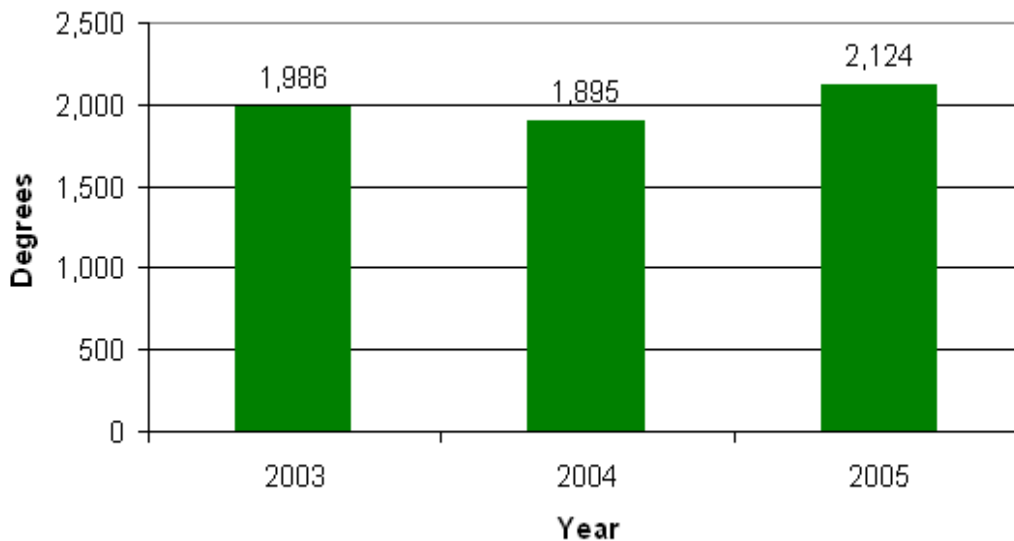

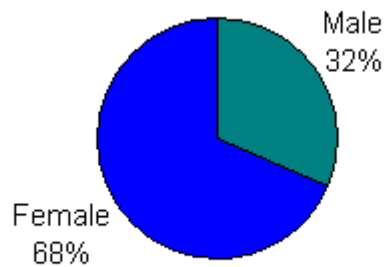
Baccalaureate Enrollment in **Animal Sciences** at [52 Institutions](#) Reporting in 2003, 2004 and 2005



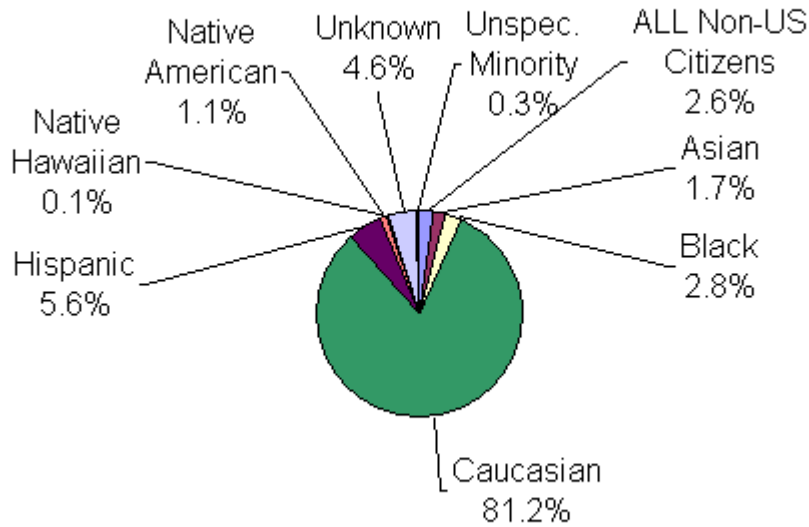
Baccalaureate Degrees Awarded in **Animal Sciences** at [43 Institutions](#) Reporting in 2003, 2004 and 2005
